Abstracts will be reviewed by the Scientific Committee and selected based on originality, significance, quality of presentation and relevance to the main issues of the symposium. Abstracts can be presented either as a poster or oral presentation. Proceedings will be published from full manuscripts invited on the basis of the poster and oral abstracts. Only original contributions will be accepted.

A provisional programme will be issued in February 2008.
